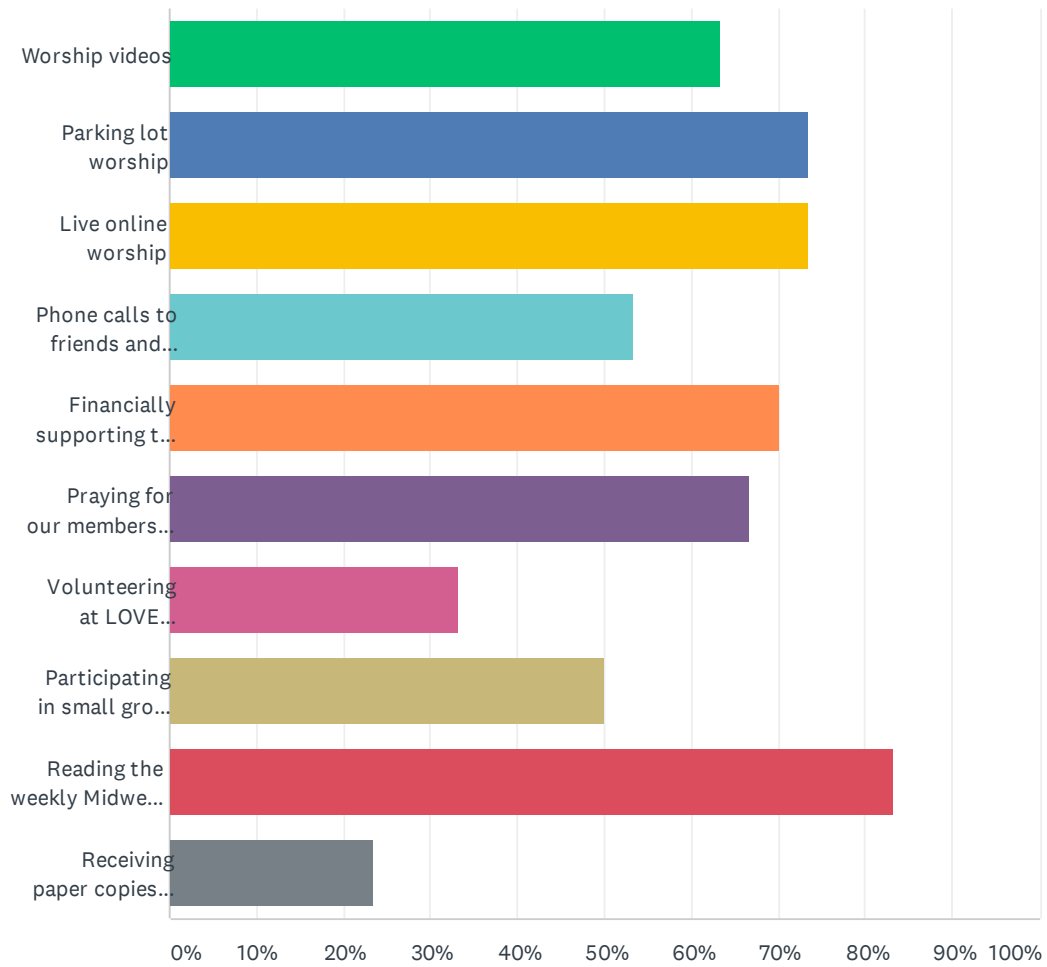


Q1 How have you been a part of the ministry of our congregation during the pandemic?

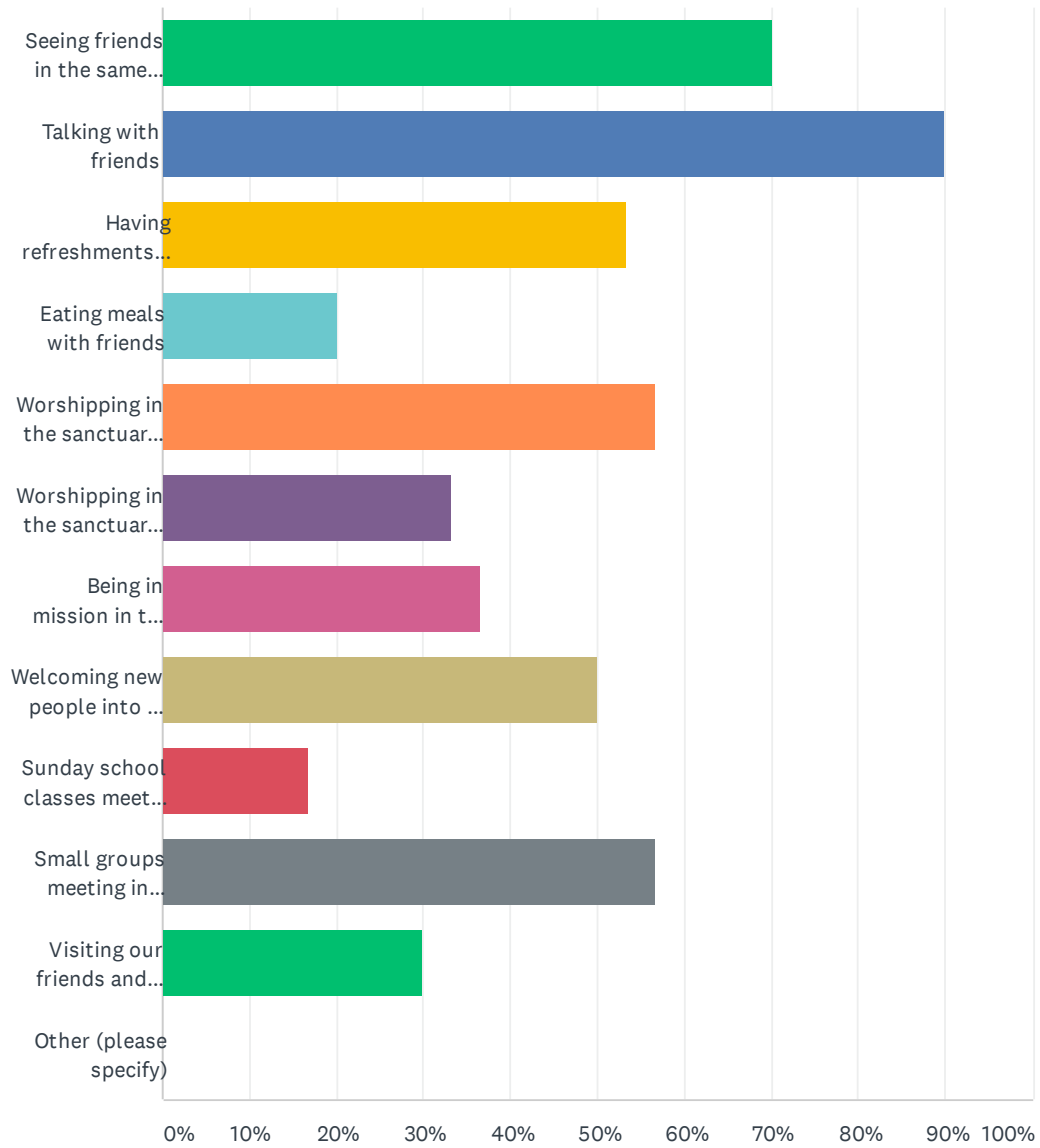

Q5 What things about church are most important to you?

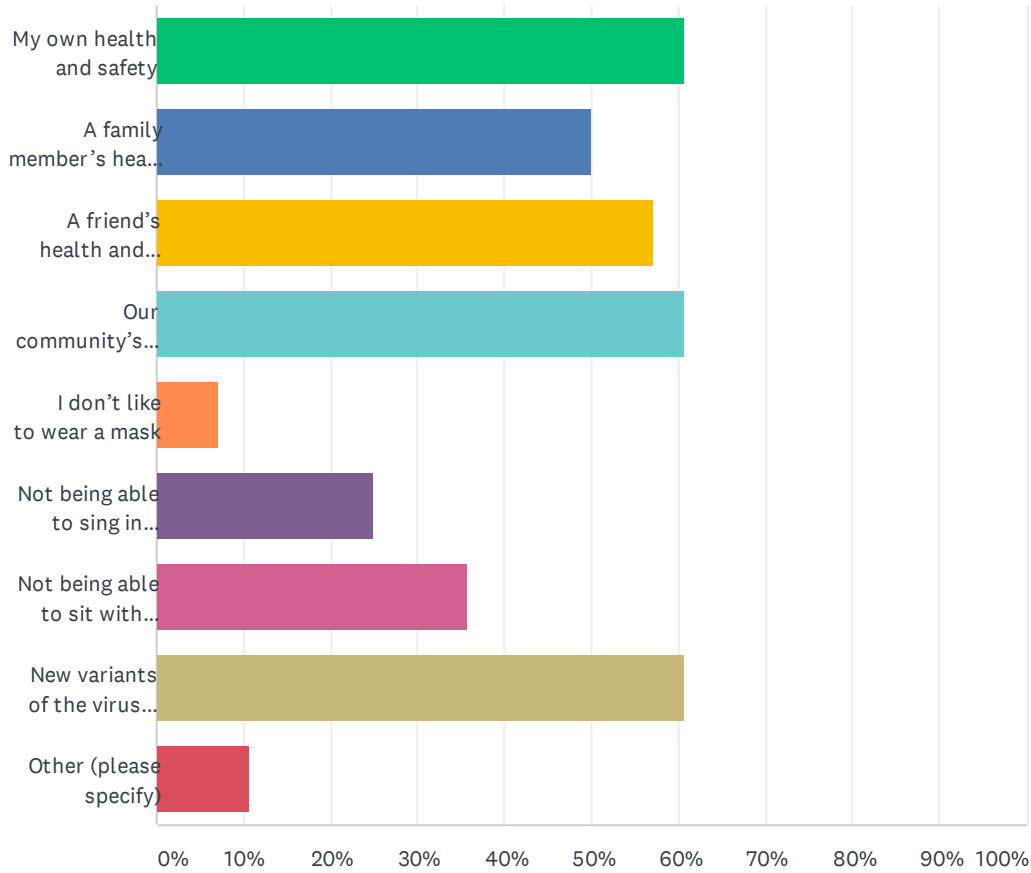

Q6 What are your concerns about gathering together again?

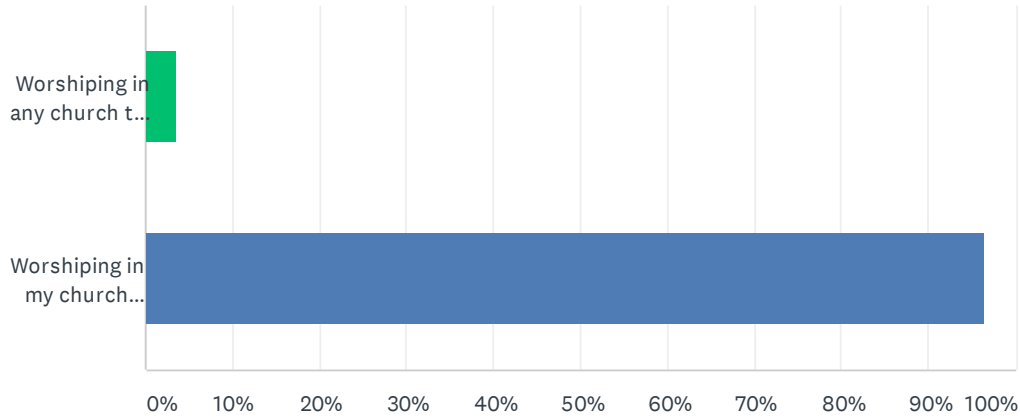
