Invitation

Christ our Lord invites to his table all who love him Who earnestly repent of their sin and seek to live in peace with one another.

(The Words of Institution)

On the night in which Jesus gave himself up for us he took bread, gave thanks to you, broke the bread, gave it to his disciples, and said: "Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you.

Do this in remembrance of me.

When the supper was over he took the cup,
gave thanks to you, gave it to his disciples, and said:
"Drink from this all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant,
poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins.

^{4:1} I'm giving you this commission in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is coming to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearance and his kingdom. ² Preach the word. Be ready to do it whether it is convenient or inconvenient. Correct, confront, and encourage with patience and instruction. ³ There will come a time when people will not tolerate sound teaching. They will collect teachers who say what they want to hear because they are self-centered. ⁴ They will turn their back on the truth and turn to myths. ⁵ But you must keep control of yourself in all circumstances. Endure suffering, do the work of a preacher of the good news, and carry out your service fully.


EUCHARIST (HOLY COMMUNION OR THE LORD'S SUPPER)


